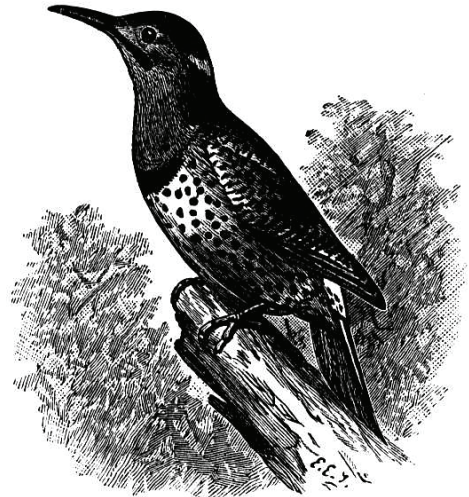

Numerous other ___ use woodpecker cavities for their own nests and shelter
 Woodpeckers look for insects under this on trees
 Woodpeckers make these in trees for their nests
 Their tongues do this into the back of their heads
 Pileated woodpeckers are about the same size as this bird
 Their skulls have extra of this
 Our smallest woodpecker
 The millions of years that woodpeckers have been around
