Loudoun County Bird Atlas Species List

Loudoun County Bird Atlasers documented 151 total species at the Blue Ridge Center between 2009 and 2014. Of these 151 species, 90 are breeding species and 61 are migratory or winter species. The breeding birds can be further divided into 37 confirmed breeders, 40 probable breeders, and 13 possible breeders.

The following table lists each documented species with its best evidence. OB (observed) indicates a species that used the Blue Ridge Center as a migratory stop-over or wintering ground. PO (possible breeder) indicates a species observed or heard during the breeding season in appropriate breeding habitat within the preserve. PR (probable breeder) indicates a species that found a mate or established a territory within the preserve, with no confirmation of breeding obtained. CO (confirmed breeder) indicates a species that was confirmed as breeding. Examples of confirmation could include observing an adult bird carrying nesting material or food, along with observations of a nest with eggs or young. An asterisk indicates a potential breeder within the Blue Ridge Center.
