


Woodpeckers

- 6 Has yellow-shafted feathers
- 7 A communication signal to establish territory
- 8 Woodpecker tongues have this attribute
- 10 Another bird that benefits from woodpecker cavities

- 12 This species of woodpecker is similar to the red-bellied but has a more crimson head
- 15 A by-product of excavating holes
- 17 To grip trees, they have two of these pointing forward and two pointing backward
- 18 Favorite food of Pileated Woodpeckers
- 20 Woodpeckers make these in snags for nesting
- 21 Number of species of woodpeckers in Loudoun
