Basic guidance: Be patient and explore – it’s powerful but can be challenging to use. To find who owns a property: On the left-hand side in the “Contents” section, check “Land Records”. Then once you get to the place on the map you want, in the top toolbar, click the “Identify” menu and pick “Land Records > Address” and then click the PIN number to open the land records in a new tab.
