Save the Dates:

- Mon., Oct. 17, 2022: Pick up your sample kit(s)
- Wed., Oct. 19, 2022: Collect water samples at your home and drop off

We test for 14 water quality parameters: *Iron, manganese, nitrate, lead, arsenic, fluoride, sulfate, pH, total dissolved solids, hardness, sodium, copper, total coliform bacteria and E. Coli bacteria*

Cost - \$60: *A comparable analysis at a private commercial lab would cost more than \$300*

Results are confidential. *It is the responsibility of the homeowner to regularly test water quality, maintain the water system, and address any problems.*
